ENVIRONMENT

ASSESS THE completing an environmental assessment is necessary to help clarify the community's demographics and needs

PROFILE understanding networks of key decision-makers and those who **LOCAL** influence them in a community **LEADERS** helps prioritize alliance work

tobacco and nicotine use, death GATHER DATA and disease prevalence, retail assessments, compliance checks, focus groups and gather public opinion

some communities are disproportionately impacted by **ASSESS IMPACT** tobacco and nicotine, analyze interventions through a health equity lens

ALLIANCE WORK

RECRUITMENT

recruit interested persons in a target community to join work group. Example: concerned parents and youth, community leaders, substance misuse professionals, etc.

FORM WORK GROUP

bring members together, educate and empower leadership

CREATE PLAN FOR CHANGE

together create goals, strategies, objectives and activities to implement a plan to introduce to the community.
