How to enter:

- Must be between 6th-12th grade
 - o Poster judging will be divided into two groups, 6th-8th grade level and 9th-12th grade level
- Must be a resident of the following counties: Barron, Burnett, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Rusk or St. Croix
- Poster must be submitted to felicia.fisk@polkcountywi.gov by April 18th, 2025
 - o With submission of poster please provide an adult's contact information
 - o Name
 - o Phone Number
 - o Email
- Winner will receive a VISA gift card. Values of the gift cards are as follows:
 - o **1st place winners:** \$300 VISA gift card
 - o 2nd place winners: \$200 VISA gift card
 - o 3rd place winners: \$100 VISA gift card
- There will be one 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winner from each group

All posters must meet the following requirements:

- All posters must be original content and not created using Artificial Intelligence
- Sized to 11"x17"
- Posters must be created digitally using resources like Canva, Microsoft Publisher, etc.
- Images and graphics included on posters must be copyright free
- Posters must be submitted as a PDF
 - o PDF must not exceed 10mb
- Information to be included on the bottom of all poster:
 - o "For help quitting call 1-800-QUIT-NOW or text READY to 34191"
 - o Add specified logos, including the Quit line and WWTFA logo
 - o Add "Designed in partnership with" and WWTFA logo and student's name
 - o The WWTFA logo can be found at <u>www.wwtfa.org</u>

1. Wisconsin Tobacco Quit Line

This is a FREE resource we promote to help people who are struggling with nicotine addiction and would like help trying to quit. The poster does not need to target a specific age range or demographic, but you can choose to if you would like.

The following requirements are:

- "Call1-800-QUIT-NOW"
- "Text READY to 34191"
- "Visit WiQuitLine.org"
- This is a free resource

o Optional: specify there is a free 2-week supply of the patch and lozenges or gum

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2. Community Cleanup Poster

This poster will be provided to community organizations as a template to promote their upcoming clean up events. This can include parks, rivers, and/or other community cleanup locations.

The following requirements are:

- A space to add date and time
- A space to add the location
- Optional: A space where a map can be added
- A fact about commercial tobacco related litter or an encouraging statement about the importance of cleaning up our community

3. "No Smoking" signage

The signage will be used at designated smoke-free areas at partnering community locations.

The following requirements are:

- Prominent red no smoking symbol (**O**) with both a combustible cigarette and an e-cigarette/vape inside.
- Large prominent text: "NO SMOKING"
- Additional smaller text: "This area is smoke-free, including electronic cigarettes"
